

MANDEVILLE, Louisiana—The Fresh Market announced today that its Mandeville store, located in the Northlake Shopping Center at the corner of North Causeway Boulevard and Highway 22, will reopen Tuesday, September 13, at 9 a.m. The store will open with an initially limited schedule of 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily.
